PLACEMENT CELL REPORT FOR 2018-19

The following are the activities of placement cell

1. <u>Technoserve Training orientation program</u>:

Technoserve is a nonprofit organization involved in the training of students under "Youth Employability program". The organization approached the college authorities and expressed their interest to train the TY class students of our college on skills required to make them more employable and ensure that the trained students are provided with placements in reputed companies. On 28th June 2018 the Technoserve team MsDebolina (9967478091) ,Ms.Harveen(8082011941) addressed TY class students from BCom/BMS/BBI and explained to the students about their program. This orientation lecture was attended by more than 200 students and was conducted in the college auditorium from 10.00 a.m to 12.00 noon. Out of these students 109 students registered for the training program.

The Technoserve assigned a team member

Ms.ShreyaKuruvilla(9971298161) to train our students. The training program started from 2nd August 2018 onwards and was conducted in 2 batches on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday from 3 to 5.00(Batch 1) and 5.00 to 7.00 (Batch 2). Students found the training program very useful and around 82 students successfully completed the training program. In the month of December 18 and January 19 ,Technoserve intends to organize a career fair for Ratnam students.

2. Athena BPO recruitment:

4. Technoserve Pre-placement talk:

A total of 71 students completed the training and the company has arranged for interviews with various employers in SNDT college Matunga. Ms. ShreyaKuruvilla the trainer assigned to Ratnam College conducted the pre placement talk on 8/12/2018 from 10.30 am to 12.20 pm and this training was attended by 70 students and students were given the identity card and instructions for the recruitment process scheduled on 22/12/2018.

After successfully completing the training program students requested for third batch of training program which was organized by placement cell during January 2019.Intotal 119 students completed the training program and 49 students have already been placed in various organizations like ICICI Prudential, Reliance Group, Kotak Mahindra Bank, IntelenetDatamatics, Yes Bank, ICICI Bank ect and the remaining students were asked to attend the subsequent career fair organized by TECHNOSERVE.

5. Placement Drive By ITM Group

Placement drive was organized for the final year students of B.Com, B.M.S., BBI, B.Sc and BA department by ITM group. They are the training partner for ICICI Bank and Axis Bank.

Ms. ShwetaGadga, Sr.Executive – sourcing from ITM group visited our campus on 16th January, 2019. This drive was conducted in AV room in two sessions.

First session: 10.30a.m to 1.00p.m

Second session: 1.00p.m to 3.00 p.m

These two sessions were attended by a total of 61 students. They started with the placement talk followed by one to one interaction (personal interview). 25 students have been shortlisted. These shortlisted students will appear for the online test followed by a personal interview by the banks.
