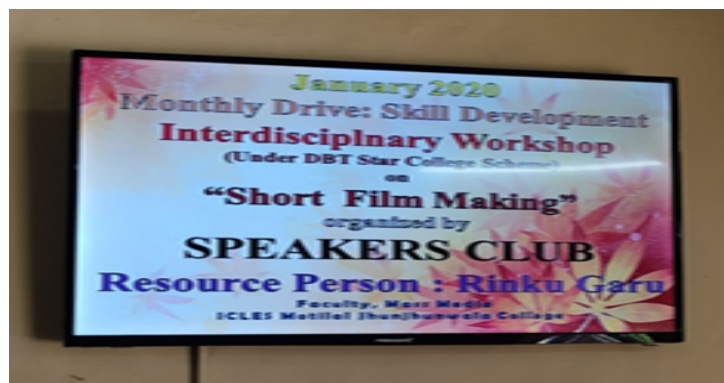

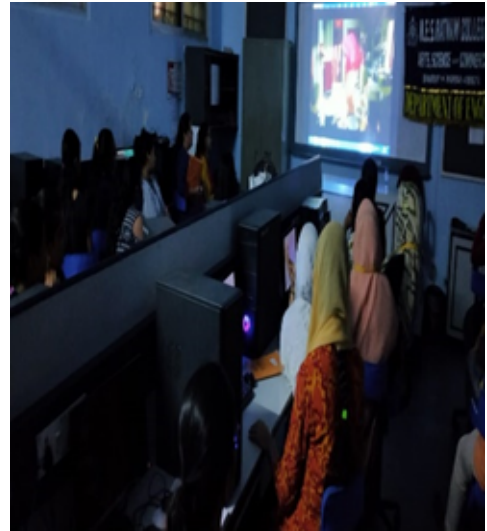


INTERDISCIPLINARY WORKSHOP ON SHORT FILM MAKING

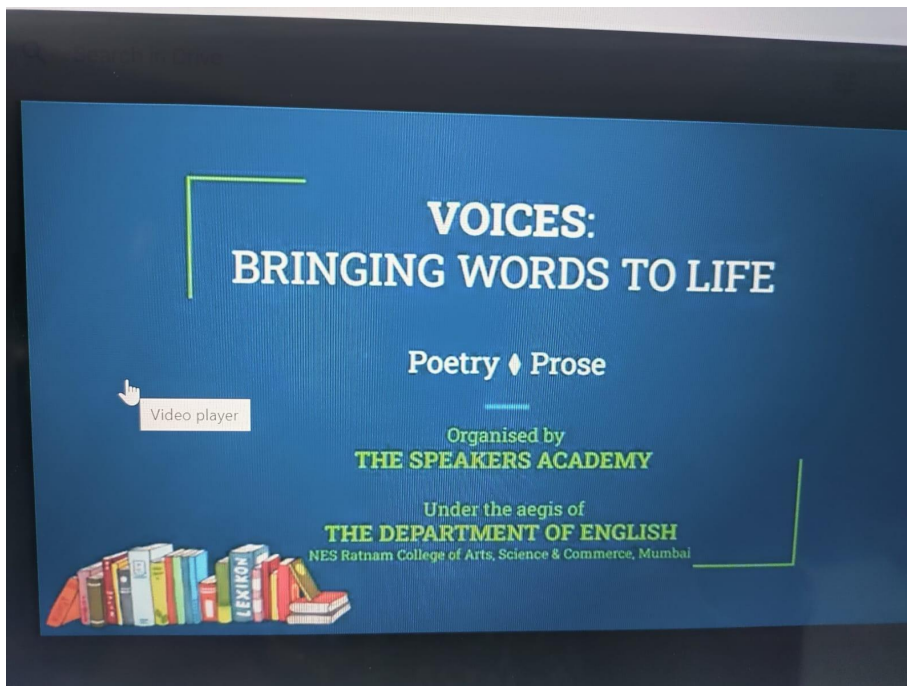

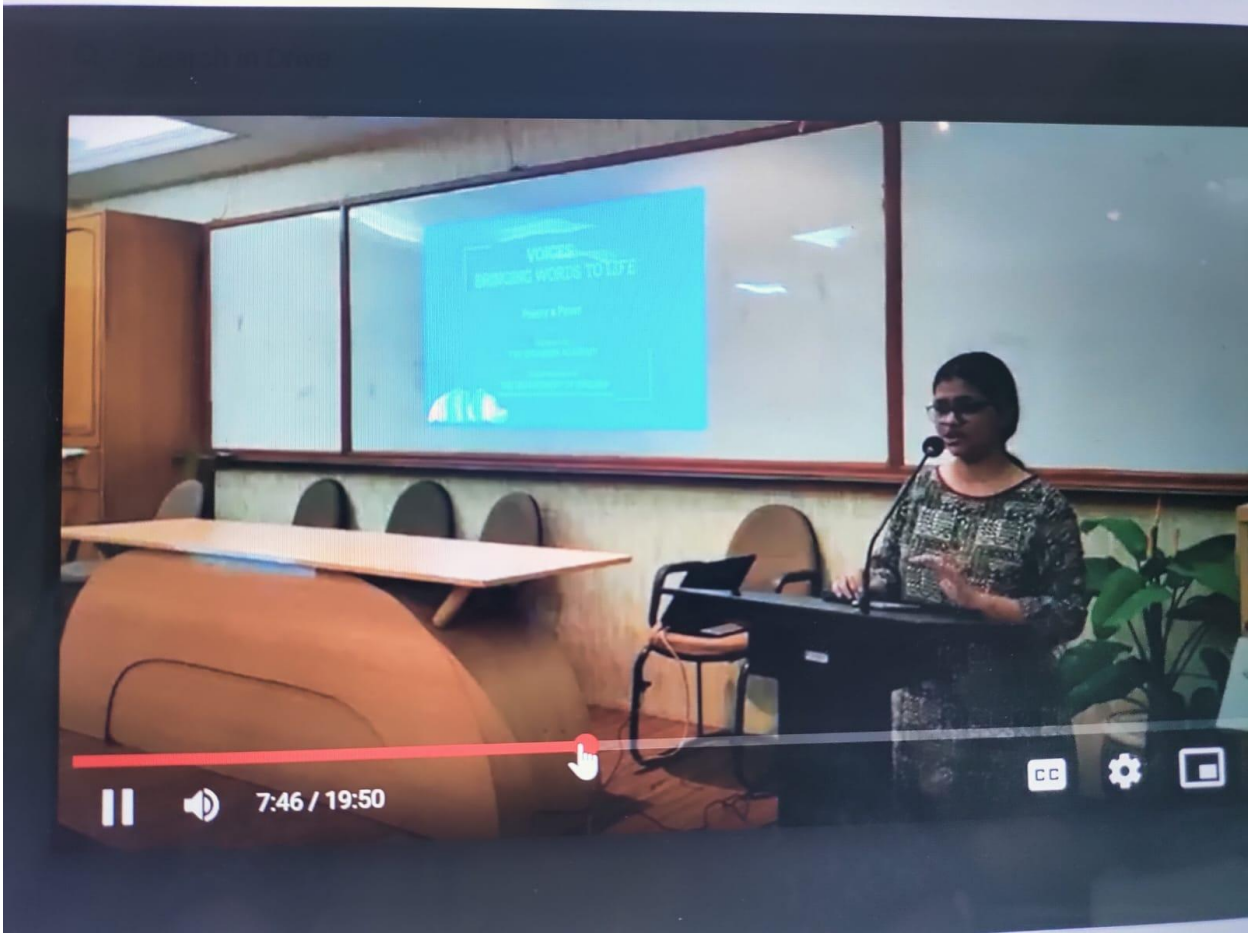
